The media area is a very friendly department, the tutors showed us everything that was required before we started anything, which reassured me and helped me to settle in.

I've been able to create my own games, learn how to evaluate the work of other artists, create scripts and edit videos of my own, recording is especially good. My favourite project was creating the games. I love gaming, so seeing what was behind the games or how they were structured was very interesting and inspired me. Having access to a range of kit and the use of Mac books, has been very useful.

The tutors have been supportive and helped me to improve. They push you to do your best and give lots of advice and guidance. They have helped me so much I can't thank them enough for their support. My advice to a new starter would be to be open to all the opportunities so you can develop a wide range of skills.

I am now progressing to Level 3, to help me get a better job and future. I am hoping to go in to the game design industry.
