Lexis: Word Formation

i.e. the various ways in which new words (or neologisms) are formed

Words formed from existing words

- Affixing involves adding prefixes or suffixes unhappy disinterested selfie
- Compounding when words are combined to form a new, larger word or expression tooth+paste=toothpaste
- Blends parts of words are joined together to form a new word
- moobs, movember, mankini
- Conversion when the word class of a word changes, creating a new use for the wordText (noun) to text (verb)

Words formed by shortening

Abbreviation or Clipping – a new word is formed by shortening an existing word

PLANE

 Acronym – words formed from the initial letters or parts of existing words

Laser: light amplification by stimulated emission of radiation

Interpol: International Criminal Police Organization

NATO:

Initialism – words abbreviated to their initial letters – BBC/NSPCC

 Eponym -Words from names – words derived from the names of people or places: DYSON, HOOVER, HAMBURGER
