

So whether you're travelling to college to attend a class or need to get to your work placement, we can provide all the information you need.

BY BUS



The college benefits from two main bus services; Stagecoach and Trentbarton which both cover Mansfield, Ashfield, the wider Nottinghamshire area and large parts of Derbyshire.

Travelling by bus is generally the cheapest option for getting around especially when using the **West Notts College Travel Pass**.

BY TRAIN



Our campuses have great connections with the Robin Hood Line which runs regular trains from Nottingham to Worksop (via Mansfield), making train travel easier than you think. If you're planning on regularly using the train, a Railcard may save you up to a third off fares.

BY BIKE

If you live within five miles of your campus, you could cycle to college in around 30 minutes. All our campuses have secure bike storage.*

ON FOOT



All our campuses are accessible on foot, so if you live within a two-mile distance of your campus, you could walk there in around 30 minutes – helping you to keep fit and healthy too.

BY CAR

It's one pass for unlimited bus travel across much of Nottinghamshire and parts of Derbyshire, 24 hours a day, 7 days per week. Check out the network map on page 156 for more information.

GREAT VALUE

It has huge savings compared to pay-as-you-go travel. Students in receipt of a bursary can even travel for free! (Subject to eligibility).

FLEXIBLE PAYMENTS

It offers flexible payment options to suit your financial needs.

MULTI-USE

It can be used on all Stagecoach and trentbarton buses across Nottinghamshire (and parts of Derbyshire), so you have the flexibility to use the pass for studying, working and socialising.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Whether it's travelling to college, a trip to catch-up with friends or visiting family, a West Notts College Travel Pass can help save you money on your bus journeys. Please note - the cost for 2024/2025 has not been confirmed but we expect the pass to be a similar price.

CRITERIA	COST
Studying a course for two or more days per week and in receipt of a bursary (any age)	Free (see points (1) and (2))
LEARNERS AGED 16-18	Subsidised price of £18 per month for 10 months - September to June (see point (2))
T-LEVEL STUDENTS	Free - this is to enable students to attend their mandatory placements with employers.
ADULT LEARNERS AGED 19+	£38 per month for 10 months - September to June
APPRENTICES (any age)	£38 per month - all year round.

(1) If your household income is less than £40,000 per annum, then you may be eligible for a bursary. Please contact the student finance team on studentfinance@wnc.ac.uk or call 01623 900455 for details. Please note, these costs are for 2023/24 and may change for 2024/25.

(2) If you live within a walking distance of 2km (1.24 miles) or less from the college, you will still be able to purchase a West Notts College Travel Pass but will pay the standard price of £38 per month (irrespective of whether you qualify for a bursary). However, if there are legitimate reasons preventing you from walking to college, you may be eligible to pay the subsidised price of £18 per year. Please note, these costs are for 2023/24 and may change for 2024/25.

LEARNER VOICE

We believe in empowering students to actively contribute to a high-quality educational experience for themselves, their peers, and future students. This is known as 'Learner Voice'. It's about giving students a say in how the college operates and a greater sense of ownership over their learning journey.





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HOW MANY SUBJECTS CAN I STUDY?

Across two years, you will either study three traditional A Level courses or choose to combine two traditional A Level courses with a vocational option. In some circumstances, you may be allowed to study four traditional A Level courses.

WHAT ARE VOCATIONAL COURSES?

For some careers, you may want to consider swapping one of your three traditional A Level courses for a vocational course. This can be a great way to develop specialised skills and knowledge that supports you in achieving your future career goals. Vocational qualifications involve a greater proportion of assessments via coursework rather than exams. You will also undertake hands-on learning to boost your employability skills and broaden future career opportunities.

We offer two vocational options

- Criminology
- Sport and Exercise Science.





ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must have a minimum of five GCSEs graded 4 or above, including English language and maths. It's important to note that certain courses may have additional entry requirements, so please visit our website for full details. If you have any uncertainties about achieving the required grades, don't hesitate to reach out to us. There are alternative pathways available to support you in reaching your desired goals.

EXTENDED PROJECT QUALIFICATION

During your second year (Year 13), you will have the opportunity to study the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) in addition to your A Levels. The EPQ is a one-year course that involves undertaking an individual research project based on your personal choice. This course not only offers extra UCAS points but also enables you to delve into a subject that may not be available as an A Level option. It allows you to obtain a qualification while exploring your own passions and interests.

The project itself can take various forms, such as written reports, performances, community projects, films, and more. Once you have completed your project, you will have the chance to deliver a presentation to the staff, students, and industry visitors, showcasing your findings and achievements.

Aged 16-18, you'll be entitled to the National Minimum Wage rate for an apprentice.

Aged 19 or over in your first year, you'll be entitled to the National Minimum Wage rate for an apprentice.

Aged 19 or over and have completed your first year, you'll be entitled to the National Minimum Wage or National Living Wage for your age.

However, rates can vary with each employer – some can and do pay more!

WHAT WILL IT COST?

Absolutely nothing! Apprenticeships are funded by the government and your employer. You will not be asked to make a financial contribution towards your learning in any way.

WHAT HOLIDAYS AND BENEFITS DO I GET?

Holiday allowances vary for every employer but the government do set a minimum standard.

Not all companies offer sick pay, so this will vary depending on the employer you join. Similarly, additional employer benefits will be confirmed to you if you are offered an apprenticeship position.

As an apprentice, you are also entitled to join a pension scheme, so this may be something you look into upon joining your new employer.



WHAT SUPPORT WILL I RECEIVE?

If required, you could receive support from our wellbeing team, our inclusion team, achievement coaches and apprenticeship team.

You will also be supported on-the-job by your employer and line manager/mentor, and have regular visits from your training specialist who will ensure that you move towards completing your apprenticeship in a timely and manageable manner.

TIPS FOR APPLYING FOR AN APPRENTICESHIP



PUT IN THE EFFORT

As with any job, you want your application to stand out so set time aside to concentrate on your application and make it unique.

MAKE A GOOD FIRST IMPRESSION

Double check your spelling, grammar and statements to show you pay attention to detail.

PRACTICE AND PREPARE

As part of your application, you will need to successfully pass an interview. Give yourself the best chance of succeeding by working with the college's apprenticeship and support teams. They can help you to prepare for questions and help manage any feelings of nerves or anxiety.

BE YOURSELF

Employers not only look for candidates with the right skills, but also the right attitude and values for their company. Tell them what achievements you're proud of, what motivates you and why you're different.
