

WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

Apprenticeships are a fantastic way of gaining recognition of your skills from undertaking paid, on-the-job training and are available for anyone aged 16+ (subject to eligibility).

Why choose an apprenticeship?

- Earn a wage, get holiday pay as well as company benefits
- Work alongside industry experts
- Gain job-specific skills
- A hands-on-experience in a sector/role of interest
- Get time for training related to your role as a mandatory part of your learning.
- Develop your English and maths skills in line with your apprenticeship's requirements and personal circumstances
- There are no debts as they are funded by the government and/or the employer
- You don't have to wait until September to start an apprenticeship. Many are available to start throughout the year.

Level 2 - equivalent to **GCSE**

ADVANCED

Level 3 - equivalent to A Level or T Level



HIGHER

Level 4/5 - equivalent to foundation degree, HNC, HND or HTQ

Tips for applying for an apprenticeship

- Put in the effort As with any job, you want your application to stand out so set time aside to concentrate on your application and make it unique.
- Make a good first impression Double check your spelling, grammar and statements to show you pay attention to detail.
- **Practice and prepare** As part of your application, you will need to successfully pass an interview. Give yourself the best chance of succeeding by working with the college's apprenticeship and support teams. They can help you to prepare for questions and help to manage any feelings of nerves or anxiety.
- **Be yourself** Employers not only look for candidates with the right skills, but also the right attitude and values for their company. Tell them what achievements you're proud of, what motivates you and why you're different.
- **Don't get disheartened** Sometimes things don't work out straight away, but that doesn't mean your journey ends there. We will continue to help you find the right opportunity so don't give up.
